	<b>PERMITTED</b> 	<b>NOT PERMITTED</b> 
<b>Hijab / headscarf</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain black or white 2-piece scarf (or wrap-around for secondary girls)</li><li>• Must cover hair, neck and up to the chin.</li></ul>	 <p>Underscarves recommended</p>	 <p>No patterned hijabs or colours other than black or white</p>
<b>Trousers</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain black or grey</li><li>• Shalwars allowed</li><li>• Joggers allowed only on PE day</li></ul>	 <p>Straight cut, medium or wide leg, regular fit or pleated; may have turn-ups; full length.</p>	 <p>No denim rivets, low waisted, stretchy material, tight, or skinny fit. Tracksuit bottoms are not allowed.</p>
<b>^Abaaya / Jilbaab</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain black or white</li><li>• can be sourced from school supplier</li></ul>		
<b>Socks</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain black or grey socks</li></ul>		 <p>Patterned, no-show, or ankle socks</p>
<b>Cardigan / Jumper</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain black or navy jumper/cardigan without a hood.</li></ul>		 <p><b>NO HOODIES ALLOWED</b></p>












# SHOES

	<b>Permitted</b> 	<b>Not Permitted</b> 
<b>Shoes / Boots</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• sensible</li><li>• plain black</li><li>• polishable</li><li>• not trainers</li><li>• not canvas</li><li>• without logos</li><li>• no high heels</li></ul> <p>Plimsolls, pumps and trainers only allowed during PE days.</p>		

# PE KIT

	<b>Permitted</b> 	<b>Not Permitted</b> 
<b>Joggers</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain black or navy</li></ul>		 <p>No stripes or big logos</p>
<b>PE Dress</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Black PE dress with school logo (covering up to the knees)</li></ul>	 <p>Embroidered school logo</p>	
<b>Footwear</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Trainers / plimsolls / pumps</li><li>• Black or white socks</li></ul>		



	<b>Permitted</b> 	<b>Not Permitted</b> 
<b>Coats</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sensible plain coats/jackets</li><li>• Hooded coats are allowed</li></ul>		 <p>No leather, denim, sweatshirts, tracksuit / hooded tops</p>
<b>Bags</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Appropriate size for schoolbooks and equipment (up to A4 size)</li></ul>		 <p>Shoulder/handbags not allowed. Also should not include large logos/ brands</p>
<b>Jewellery</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One single pair of plain silver/gold stud earrings for girls only. No other piercings are permitted.</li><li>• Students are permitted to wear a necklace inside the shirt but it must be removed during PE.</li></ul>		 <p>No rings or bracelets</p>
<b>Makeup and Nails</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No make-up is allowed.</li><li>• Nail varnish (clear or coloured), false nails and false eyelashes are not allowed.</li></ul>		
<b>Piercings</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Facial, body piercings and stretchers are not allowed.</li><li>• Wearing of any facial/body piercing jewellery is not acceptable anywhere on the school premises for health and safety reasons.</li></ul>		 <p>No facial piercings</p>



# SANCTIONS

Any student who is not following the school's uniform rules will be subject to the below escalation procedure:

1. **First Breach** – gentle reminder to given to pupil around uniform compliance and breach explained.
2. **Second Breach** – email/SMS sent to parents reminding them of uniform policy and breach explained. Opportunity to comply provided.
3. **Third Breach** – parent contacted, extenuating circumstances explored before pupil sent home (or parents called) and asked to return with correct uniform.

# PURCHASING

School uniform can be purchased from any local retailers or online stores. Abayas/PE dresses for girls can be sourced directly from the school's supplier by completing the form on the School Uniform page of the website.

Uniform clothing to be purchased well in advance of term start date including any extra pairs required in the event of loss or damage.
